1) Payment Options:

A) Direct Debit: Full fees will be paid over 6 months. If a player has joined during the season the Direct Debit will be over fewer months. The payments will be debited on the 28th of each month. The available months for these payments are from April to September (6).

Direct Debit forms can be found online or at the club rooms. These should be returned to the club rooms or to the treasurer.

B) Payment in full: Fees can be paid in full by EFT, cash or cheque. Part payment by these methods is not accepted.

EFT: Include your first initial and surname in the payment narrative. Please complete an individual payment for each member.

Cash or Cheque: Please place your cash or cheque in an envelope with your name(s) written on it and return it to the club rooms or to the treasurer.

2) Definition of being "Financial" for senior players:

When full fees are due a player must have paid in full or have submitted a signed Direct Debit in order to be financial.

A senior player can participant in up to 3 games at a cost of \$15 per game. When a senior player has participated in 4 or more games the full registration fee is due to Lacrosse Victoria. Therefore that is the point at which full fees are due to the Malvern Lacrosse Club.

If a direct debit payment is refused that player will no longer be a financial member of the club. If this occurs please contact the treasurer to arrange another form of payment asap.

3) Senior Player Selection

Men: Throughout the season the treasurer will supply the head of the match committee with an up to date list of players who are financial and therefore available for selection.

Women: Throughout the season the treasurer will supply the woman's coach with an up to date list of players who are financial and therefore available for selection.

Exception 1: From time to time ex players have been requested by the club to take the field due to a lack of players. Generally the club will cover these player's fees up to 3 games per season which is \$45.

Exception 2: The club currently recruits college players from America. In their first year their fees are covered by the club. This is to help offset some of their travel costs.

4) Junior Player Selection

The treasurer will liaise with the Junior Co-ordinator throughout the season on any issues relating to the payment of fees. Issues will be approached on a case by case base.

5) Representative/State Junior Players

Any junior player who participates in try outs for representative or state teams will be refunded the try out fee. The player will pay Lacrosse Victoria and then submit the receipt to the treasurer for a refund.

6) Social Membership

Social memberships are available to non players who wish to be a member of Malvern Lacrosse club. Paying a social membership entitles the member to vote at a club general meeting.
